

NORWEGIAN BUHUND CLUB of the UK



Judges List Criteria

1. A1 List

For persons who have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed and have completed their first appointment. To have the support of the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK (KC Policy)

2. A2 List

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A2 list. To have the support of the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK (KC Policy)

3. A3 List Breed Specialist

Those whom the Norwegian Buhund Club would support to award Challenge Certificates in the breed but have not yet been approved by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A2 List

The Judges Sub-committee will decide by a majority vote on acceptance onto the list or otherwise.

1. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 Norwegian Buhunds when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances) (KC Policy)
2. Minimum of seven years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK (KC Policy)
3. To have stewarded at 12 shows. (KC Policy)
4. Must state they are prepared to write show critiques.
5. Must have been on the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK B list for at least four years.
6. Must have judged 20 classes of Norwegian Buhunds and 40 dogs. (KC Policy)
7. Must have judged the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK Open Show or at least 2 Championship Shows without CCs, with 6 or more classes for the breed.
8. To have attended at least one Breed specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable (KC Policy)
9. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Confirmation and Movement (KC Policy)

10. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examination on KC Regulations and Judging Procedures. (KC Policy)
11. To have attended a Points of the Dog Assessment conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. (KC Policy)

4 A3 Non-Specialist

Those whom the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK would support to award Challenge Certificates in the breed but have not yet been approved by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A2 List.

1. Minimum of seven years judging experience in any one breed (to include five years in this breed) and have the support of the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK (KC Policy)
2. To have judged a Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK Open Show or at least 2 Championship Shows without CCs with 6 or more Classes for the Breed.
3. Must have judged 14 classes and 30 dogs.
4. To have awarded CCs in at least one other Breed (KC Policy)
5. To have attended at least one Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

5. B List Breed Specialist

Those whom the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK would support to judge the breed at Championship shows without Challenge Certificates on offer and at Open Shows.

The Judges Sub-committee will decide by majority vote on acceptance onto the list or otherwise.

1. To have 5 years experience, owning and or exhibiting Norwegian Buhunds.
2. To have judged 5 classes of Norwegian Buhunds at Open shows or Championship shows without CCs.
3. To have judged at least 10 dogs of Norwegian Buhunds
4. To have the support of the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK.

6. B List Non-Specialist

Those whom the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK would support to judge the breed at Championship shows without Challenge Certificates on offer and at Open shows.

The Judges Sub-committee will decide by majority, vote on acceptance onto the list or otherwise.

1. To have a minimum of 5 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK.
2. To have judged 5 classes of this breed at Open shows or Championship shows without CCs (Save in exceptional circumstances)

3. To have judged 10 dogs of this Breed.

7. C List Breed Specialist

All applications for inclusion to the C List will be vetted by the Judges Sub-committee who will by a majority, vote on acceptance to the list or otherwise.

For aspiring judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the Norwegian Buhund Club of the UK.

8. C List Non-Specialist

All applicants for inclusion to the C list will be vetted by the Judges Sub-committee who will by a majority, vote on acceptance on the list or otherwise.
